MERGE engages people of *all* genders through participatory learning and guided reflection and helps communities design and implement strategies that support men and boys while achieving social change. We establish community-based partnerships, working in collaboration with practitioners and organizations in the fields of education, social work, mental health, public health, fathering, violence prevention and more, to identify the most effective strategies for change.

## BUILDING CAPACITIES TRAINING AND CONSULTING

Through incremental skill-building sessions (trainings) and expert support (consulting), MERGE provides the coaching, mentoring, and expert knowledge that help build the capacities of practitioners and organizations.

**MERGE Trainings** range from eight-hour to multi-day sessions that are highly participatory—promoting personal reflection and cross-gender dialogue. These trainings include:

**Developing Healthy Boys and Men:** explore male gender socialization and teach strategies and skills for promoting the development of compassionate, non-violent and equitable boys and men.

Facilitating Difficult Conversations about Gender, Race and Trauma: learn and practice facilitating interpersonal and community dialogue, strengthen our ability to reach across differences, and increase our collective capacity to create safe and resilient communities.

**Training of Trainers:** intensive hands-on training that prepares participants to lead trainings through practice sessions, coaching, group feedback and supervised community practicum. A facilitator handbook with a detailed curriculum is also provided.

**MERGE wrap-around Consulting** services support organizational partners and community leaders in building local capacity to extend the impact of MERGE trainings.

## CONNECTING. LEARNING. INSPIRING ANNUAL SUMMIT

The MERGE Annual Summit is held on the Wednesday before Father's Day and brings together professionals and community leaders from diverse organizations and communities. During this daylong event, individuals have a chance to locate their work and their impact as part of the larger community of change agents.
